

Template for an Abstract in JPS meetings

This is a template for an abstract in JPS meetings in a MS Word document. The page size is A4 in the portrait format. The font species should be Times or its families. The title is written in a 16-point bold font, while the names and the affiliations are in a 14-point bold font. The affiliations are, in addition, in italic. The text is written in a 12-point font. The page margins are: 30 mm for the top and 25 mm for the bottom, 20 mm each for the left and the right.

The above numbers are as a guide. Some additional rules are listed below:

- 1) Please do not put the presentation ID anywhere on this sheet.
- 2) Please do not put any frame.
- 3) The submission should be in pdf format with fonts embedded. No MS Word file is accepted.
- 4) The length limit is one page for contributed presentations and two pages for the other invited presentations including those in symposia.
- 5) The file size should be less than 2 MB for contributed presentations and less than 4 MB for the other invited presentations including those in symposia.
- 6) Hyperlinks to some web sites or media are prohibited.
- 7) The copyright belongs to JPS.
- 8) Those who purchase the rights to access can browse the abstracts on the JPS website for a year from the meeting. After one year, they will be open on J-Stage. One may also purchase a DVD medium of the abstracts.
